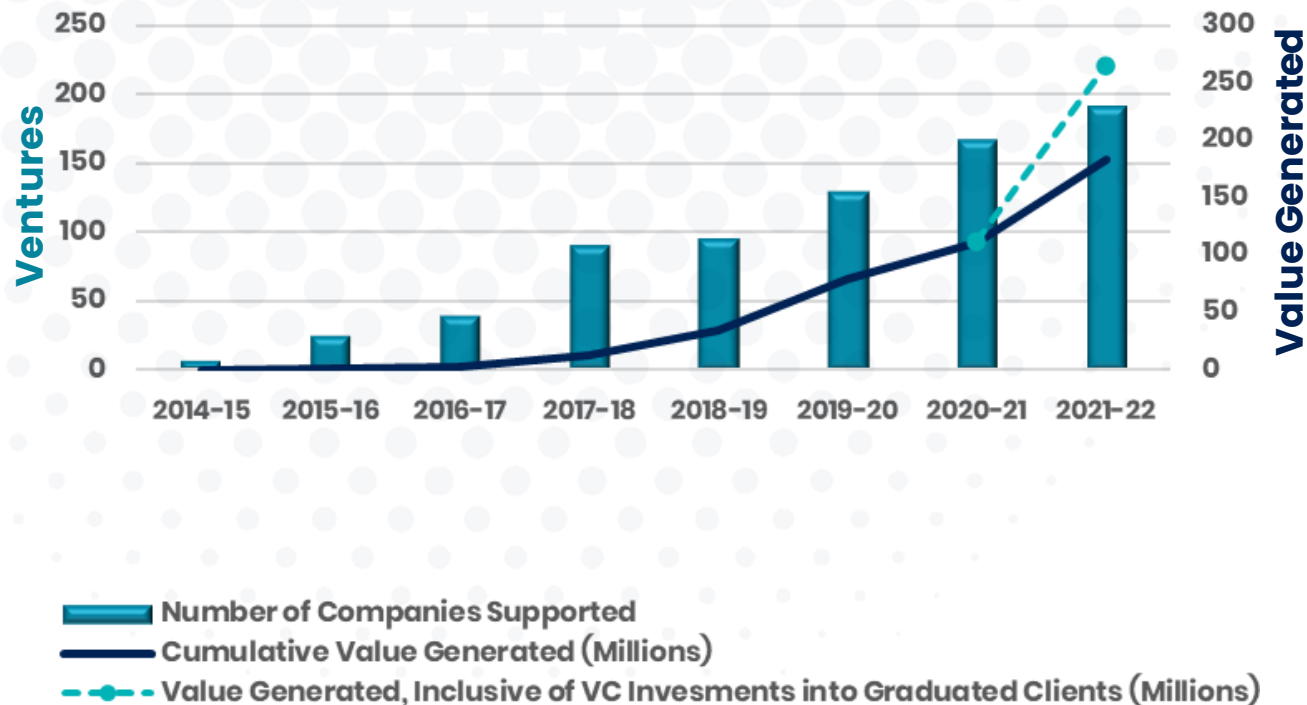

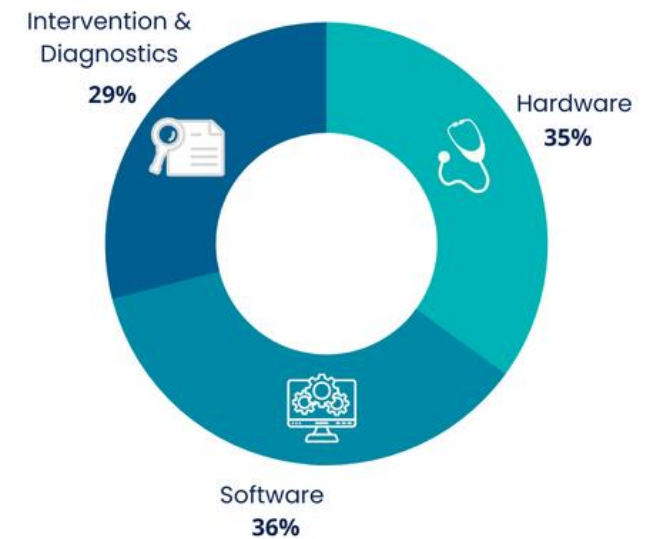


A GROWING CLIENT PORTFOLIO

GMCA BUSINESS FUNDAMENTALS



GMCA: Business Fundamentals (formerly GMCA mini-MBA) is a 10-week online course designed to provide graduate students and postdoctoral fellows with an introduction to fundamental business concepts. Lectures are taught by industry professionals from diverse backgrounds and cover concepts from the popular “The Ten-Day MBA” book by Steven Silbiger.

Trainees then apply concepts learned from the course directly to a business problem in a case competition judged by consultants and industry professionals. Registration fees for H2i client companies to participate in this course are covered by the H2i program.

HEALTH ENTREPRENEURSHIP CHALLENGE (HENT)



The **African Higher Education Health Collaborative**, comprised of ten partners including eight African Universities, University of Toronto and Mastercard Foundation, is a collaborative with a vision to create Africa-centric economic growth in the health sector, and ultimately create millions of jobs over the 10-year term of the program. This vision, which has particular focus on youth and women, looks to achieve this through 3 distinct pillars: **Health Employment, Health Entrepreneurship (HENT)**, and **Health Ecosystems**. H2i has the chair of the HENT committee in the early years of the program.

H2i, alongside ICUBE (UTM) and The BRIDGE (UTSC), are excited to partner with the collaborative network to support their Health Entrepreneurship Pillar. The early stages of this work, which will take place over the next ten years, got started in Fall 2021.

As part of this and heading into 2022-23, H2i is supporting the running of the **Health Entrepreneurship Challenge**. The goal of the HENT Challenge is to enable the creation of ventures with positive outcomes in Africa.



FEM>STEM

In 2017 H2i launched its **FemSTEM** program with the goal to inspire, engage, and celebrate women entrepreneurs.

FemSTEM is our dedicated program focused on fostering an increasingly diverse and inclusive community. We are committed to supporting women and building valuable and diverse connections, and to uplifting women in STEM who are looking to create their own business. From 2017-2021, the program was comprised of a multi-event series, with a pitch competition being added in 2021.

In 2021, we asked women founders how we could further support them. The resounding response was to expand our FemSTEM programming to be year-round, with a focus on one-on-one mentorship from women founders and networking opportunities.

As a direct result of this, H2i launched **FemSTEM Mentoring** in early 2022, and have since connected six H2i women founders seeking mentorship from women, with leading experts in their areas of need and focus.
