In 2023-24, H2i continued its record of providing outstanding and impactful mentorship, supporting our diverse international health technology client community. This year saw the expansion of our lead Level 3 Mentor Team, welcoming Neil D'Cruz, David Latner, Fraidianie Sévigné, and Dr. Kamran Khan. This marked the beginning of succession planning after a decade of venture support, with the formal retirement of H2i Associate Director Andris Lauris, who was instrumental in building out H2i's Level 3 and 4 venture vision. Our diversity and scope of industry mentors grew and contributed over 2600 mentorship hours to H2i's 248 startups. Ventures generated \$122M revenue (16M non-dilutive+80M equity+26M sales) and have been featured across the UofT Entrepreneurship ecosystem and externally, as model early health ventures.

This new growth is the product of the whole H2i community, which is celebrating its 10th anniversary in 2024. As the sole health-focused campus-linked accelerator at UofT, H2i provides support for health startups across the university throughout their venture pathway, without jurisdictional limitations (across the tri-campus; and strategically on behalf of UofT at the provincial, national, international levels). With a growing portfolio of African ventures as part of the Africa Higher Education Health Collaborative and in partnership with the Mastercard Foundation, H2i supported UofT's VP-International mission in its global commitment to ensure equitable access to entrepreneurial resources and activities, in addition to helping build mentors and KOL cohorts, while developing additional EDI-centric activities (e.g. FemSTEM domestic and now Africa series).

This year was a year of change, which saw new leadership, a partnership with Lab2Market, and more efforts in advocacy for wet lab venture hoteling, investor readiness, and expansion of national and international partnerships. Our team at H2i hopes that this momentum will carry towards catalyzing the health innovation and commercialization agenda at the University of Toronto, into the next decade. 3





WET LAB SPACES FOR HEALTH SCIENCE STARTUPS

In November 2023, H2i partnered with **MaRS Discovery** to host an inperson event to explore how early-stage health science startups are navigating their wet lab space needs and how the healthcare community can foster a robust ecosystem of health innovation in the future ahead.

The panel and networking event aimed to cultivate conversation between entrepreneurs and wet lab space providers—with a unique panel featuring speakers from **startups**, **labs**, **academia**, **hospitals**, **real estate**, and **advocacy coalitions**. The **100+ attendees** were able to learn what is currently available, gain insight into navigating existing challenges, and join the important conversation of how collaboration among the health science community paves an important path in **growing a local**, thriving wet-based venture community.







In 2017, H2i launched its **FemSTEM** program with the goal to inspire, engage, and celebrate women entrepreneurs.

FemSTEM is our dedicated program focused on fostering an increasingly diverse and inclusive community. We are committed to supporting women and building valuable and diverse connections, and to uplifting women in STEM who are looking to create their own business.

In 2021, we asked women founders how we could further support them. As a direct result of this, H2i launched **FemSTEM Mentoring** in early 2022. In 2024, as part of H2i's involvement in the <u>Africa Health Collaborative</u> and in partnership with the Mastercard Foundation, H2i joined with **Social Enterprise Ghana** and **Sustineri Attorneys** to host **FemSTEM Africa**.



The impact of FemSTEM programming is clearly demonstrated by the rise in the proportion of women-founded ventures in H2i. In 2017, only 5% of H2i ventures were women-founded. **Since the program expansion in 2021, women-led companies have risen from 28% to 56% in just three years. In 2023-24, 79% of H2i HENT African ventures were led by women founders.**
